STUDENTS TAKE THE MIC FOR ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE



This month, Global Kids highlighted environmental justice within our communities and tasking students with projects to identify local issues and solutions. Students at **Global Kids HQ** wrapped up the Spring Break Leadership Institute with a special visit from **Victoria Moran Garcia**, a Lehman **College senior**. Chosen by her professor to start a podcast on environmental justice in the Bronx, Victoria shared her journey and inspired students to become storytellers themselves.

For their final activity, students began drafting their own podcast scripts based on the environmental issues they explored throughout the program—using their voices to spark change in their communities.

Students from the **High School for Public Service** joined the Spring Break Leadership Institute for a special day of fieldwork at the Water Alliance in Prospect Park. There, they gained hands-on experience in water testing and lab work, learning how science and environmental justice intersect in real-world settings.

BEFORE YOU SAY YES: MUST-DO CHECKLIST

1. Review Your Acceptance Letters

Check all offers and make sure you understand the details of each.

2. Compare Financial Aid Packages

Look at scholarships, grants, loans, and total costs—know what you're signing up for. **NEGOTIATE YOUR OFFERS!!**

3. Speak with Your College/GK Counselor

Get guidance, ask questions, and talk through your options—they're here to help you make a confident choice.







4. Visit the College (If You Can)

Seeing the campus in person can help you decide if it feels like the right fit. Take a tour, talk to students, and explore!

5. Secure Your Spot with a Deposit


Most schools ask for a tuition deposit—make sure it's paid on time.
