SUMMER GOALS: WHAT'S NEXT?

Rising Seniors:

- Finalizing your college list

Rising Juniors:

- Exploring career interests
- Starting a resume or activity list
- Beginning SAT/ACT prep

Junior and Senior Years = Big Changes From harder classes to college and career planning, these years can be a lot. Regular check-ins help teens feel supported and stay on track.



WHAT DOES COMMUNICATION WITH YOUR STUDENT LOOK LIKE?

STEP 1:

A Safe Space to Decompress:

- · Ask for help without judgment
- Talk through big decisions
- Take a break from pressure

STEP 2:

Conversation Starters

Rising Junior

- Have you talked with your GK staff or counselor about college or careers yet?
- Have you thought about taking any SAT/ACT practice or prep?
- Is there a career or subject you're curious to learn more about?
- What's one thing you'd like to improve or focus on this year?

Rising Senior

 Have you started thinking about your plans after graduation?

- Is there a college, job, or training program you're interested in?
- What support do you need this year to stay on track?
- Have you started your college or job applications yet? Need help?

STEP 3:

Tips to Keep in Mind:

Be consistent:

Regular check-ins, even if brief, go a long way.

Talk about goals and challenges:

Support them in thinking ahead—college, career, or next steps.

Celebrate progress, not just perfection:

Acknowledge effort and growth.

Use positive language:

Encourage, uplift, and show you're proud—even when offering feedback.
